## BASE LECTURE SERIES BRINGS EXPERTISE OF INDUSTRY LEADERS TO OUR BUSINESS COMMUNITY

The next presentation in the Building a Sustainable Economy lecture series will be **Fri., Nov. 16: "The New Sustainability Advantage"** with **Bob Willard**, a leading expert on quantifying and selling the business value of corporate sustainability strategies. The fact that he will be on the island at all is thanks to the Hybrid MBA program at Bainbridge Graduate Institute (BGI).

**BGI began an industry movement** by offering the first MBA in Sustainable Business in 2002. Its founders created BGI to develop business solutions for the world's most pressing challenges. BGI's MBA and Certificate programs are specifically designed to integrate sustainability—environmentally and socially responsible practices—with traditional business education. Today, hundreds of business schools world-wide have followed their lead with sustainable business programs.

**BGI's Hybrid MBA Program** brings students and faculty together from around the world each month to the IslandWood campus on Bainbridge Island. A guest speaker who is an industry leader in sustainable business practices is an important component of each four-day intensive.

In the spring of 2012, BGI expressed a desire to be more involved in the local community. Conversations between BGI graduates

on Bainbridge and members of the Bainbridge Chamber board sparked the idea of approaching the BGI guest speakers about including a presentation to the general public as part of their stay on the island. Four organizations - **BGI, the Bainbridge Chamber, Sustainable Bainbridge and the Bainbridge Public Library** – came together to plan a series of monthly public lectures sharing the knowledge and expertise of these remarkable people.

**The first public lecture** in May was presented by Adam Siegel, Vice President of Sustainability and Retail Operations for the Retail Industry Leaders Association. Subsequent speakers have included original BGI founders Gifford Pinchot III and Jill Bamburg, BGI Dean and Vice President of Academic Affairs John Gardner, BGI graduate Tony D'Onofrio, now Sustainability Director for Town and Country Markets Inc, and Marjorie Kelly, of the Tellus Institute in Boston and Cutting Edge Capital, who explored recent innovations in forms of business ownership.

The earlier lectures were held at the auditorium of the Bainbridge Island Museum of Art. An admission fee was charged to cover hall rental. Later lectures have been at the large meeting room of the Bainbridge Library. There is no admission cost, although attendees are requested to RSVP online. A reception follows each lecture.

"We realize that 6 PM on a Friday may not be the most popular time slot," said Rex Oliver, Bainbridge Chamber President & CEO, "but that's the only time available in the guest speakers' schedules."
