## **FAQs & BY THE NUMBERS**

- **Grand Old 4<sup>th</sup>** – Was started by the Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce in 1967 and is celebrating its 55<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. Yes, we even did a scaled down version during COVID.
- **Why was it started?** It was started as a way to bring the community together to celebrate Independence Day, connect businesses, friends and neighbors and also welcome visitors.
- **How does this event fit in with Celebrate Bainbridge Island, Rotary Auction, etc?** Islanders clearly love the Fourth and this year there is a lot of cause for celebration. As a community of civic organizations, we're excited to have the opportunity this long weekend to showcase the best of the island's renowned traditions. It's also helped us work together to save time and resources by hosting the events concurrently.
- **Parade floats/participating organizations?** 70 youth and community organizations, local businesses, and civic leaders
- **How many Street Fair Vendors?** 85 civic, arts, artisans, food and beverage vendors are participating this year.
- **How many cars entered?** We won't know a final number until later today but as of June 29, 70 were entered.
- **How many volunteers?** More than 100
- **How many people attend this event?** In past years we have roughly estimated between 15,000 and 20,000.
- **Why aren't there Fireworks?** Fireworks on Bainbridge Island had a longstanding tradition, however, the leaders of the nonprofit who led that effort have since retired. We are always looking for volunteers to take up the mantle, should someone wish to restart the tradition.
- **Where can I see fireworks?** There are many places around Bainbridge Island from which you can view fireworks displays in Puget Sound, including Fay Bainbridge Park, the ferry terminal, Point White Pier, Lynwood Center/Pleasant Beach, Rolling Bay, Manitou Beach (overlooks Seattle), Rockaway Beach.
- **What is the ZERO WASTE INTIATIVE?** As part of our community's response to climate change and commitment to preserving our environment, the island is working to sharply decrease the amount of single-use service-ware. Vendors will be using alternative fiber-based compostable items wherever possible. Please be aware of the recycling, compost and garbage streams.

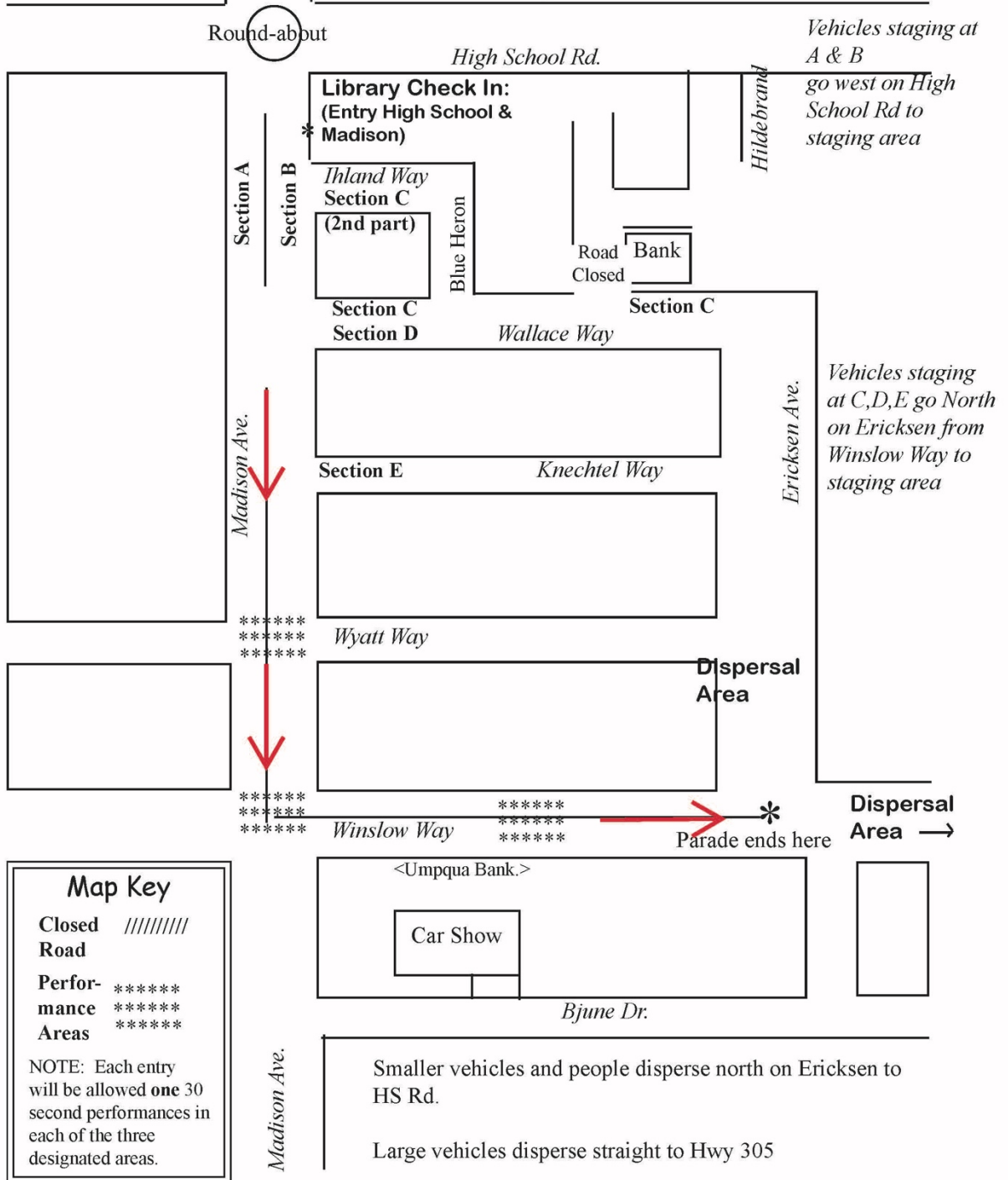

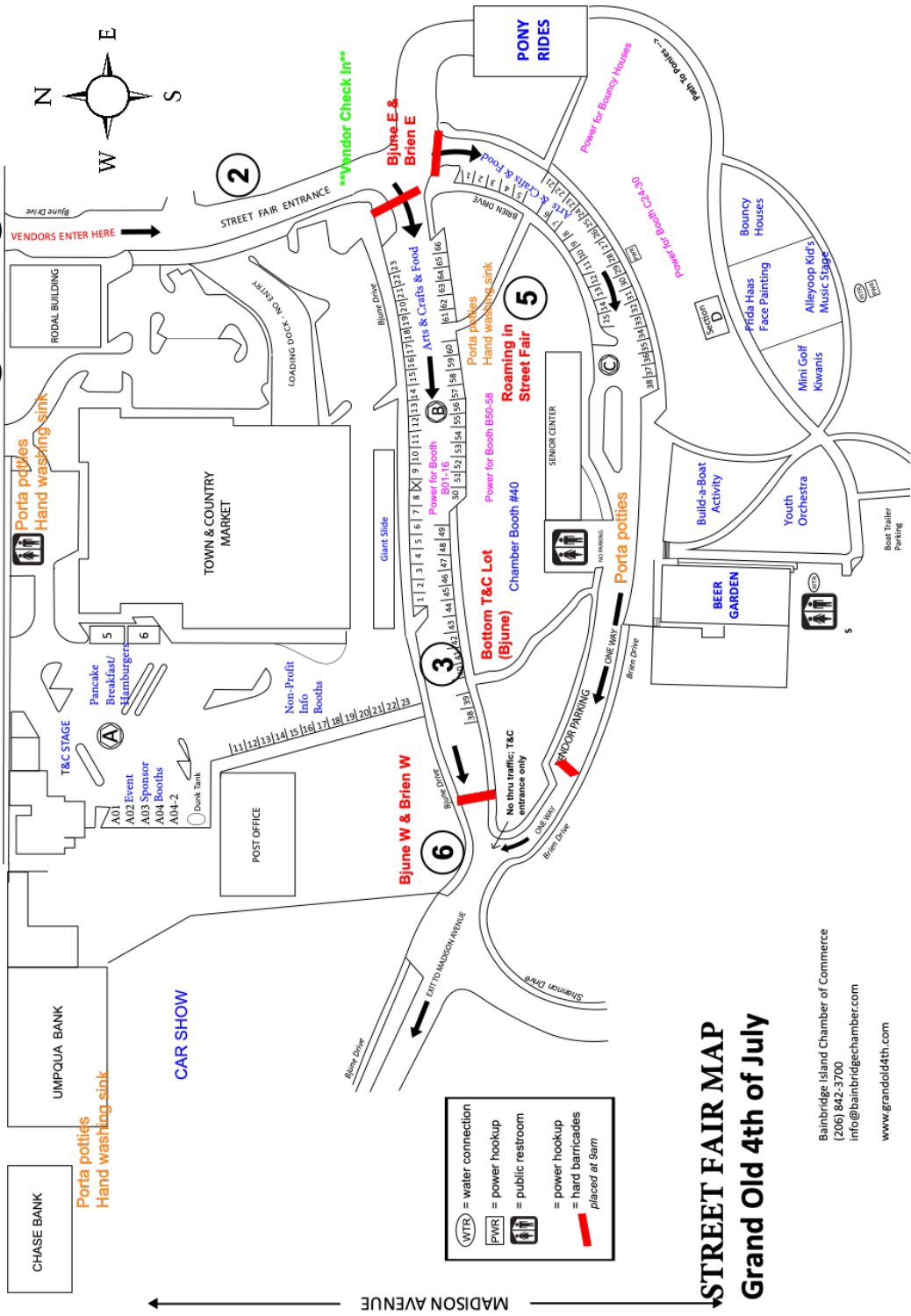
