

Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce Street Fair Vendor Acceptance 2023

We are happy that you will be joining us at the 2023 Grand Old 4th Celebration! A map of the festival area with your booth location highlighted is enclosed.



Set-up & Teardown:

- **Note the direction of vehicle access and egress**
- **Set-up is July 4 from 6:00am to 8:30am**
- Street Fair opens to the public promptly at 9am on July 4
- No set-up the evening of July 3rd
- No vehicles are allowed in the booth area July 4 from 8:30am to 5:00pm.
- **No teardowns before 5:00pm, July 4. No exceptions.**

Allow time for the ferry, traffic, etc. to avoid being late. Download the Washington State Ferries app for the most up-to-date information – schedules may change.

What to Bring?

- Your 10x10 tent, tables, chairs, signage, reusable water bottles (we will have water jugs available throughout the Street Fair to fill up your bottle), and extension cords (for vendors who pre-paid the Electric Power Connection fee).

Place the enclosed “Vendor Parking Permit” in your vehicle window and proceed to the Reserved Vendor Parking Area near the Bainbridge Performing Arts Center and Island Fitness (see vendor parking map). There is no vendor parking in the T & C (grocery store) parking lot.

Parking is limited.

- Only one parking permit will be issued per vendor, so please carpool with other booth workers.
- One car per booth.
- ***Please keep pass on dash when loading in.***

Please help keep our festival clean. Please use the compost/recycling/trash areas set aside for the vendors on Bjune Drive rather than the public cans. ***See enclosed Recycling Info document or vendor website for more information.***

State of Washington requires **vendor permits** and **food handling cards** for all **food vending booths**. Your form must be completed and returned to the health department two weeks prior to the event. For information call: Kitsap Health Department at 360-337-5235.

If **lodging** is desired, reservations are required. Marshall Suites (206-855-9666), Quality Inn & Suites (206-842-6861), Pleasant Beach Village Inn (206-866-6499), & Clearwater Casino Resort (800-375-6073) may have rooms available. Fay Bainbridge Park allows overnight tent and RV camping with available on a first-come, first-served basis at 206-842-3931. For Bed and Breakfasts, see VisitBainbridge.com.

2023 Bainbridge Island Low-Waste Events Required Types of Vendor Tableware



Bainbridge Island Zero Waste volunteers and the BI Chamber of Commerce are working hard to make sure this event creates as little trash as possible. You play your part by serving food in compostable fiber tableware, as described below. Our guests like not having to trash the food service ware, which is only possible on Bainbridge when you use natural fiber-based, PFAS-free service ware. Look for natural fiber products certified by [Biodegradable Products Institute](#) or [OK Compost HOME](#) to easily comply with City regulations.

Note: The City of Bainbridge Island passed an ordinance effective January 1, 2022, that requires all lids, cups, straws/stirrers, utensils and condiments be kept out of customer reach. You may not automatically provide these items, except for cups and hot beverage lids. You must either ask the customer, or they must request these items, before you give them out. (This does not apply to napkins.)

Wooden/fiber utensils are required. If you want to purchase from Zero Waste for this event only (since there is a discard arrangement to be able to compost them after use), we will sell wooden ones at a subsidized \$3/sleeve of 100. Feel free to email or call with any questions:

DO NOT USE any kind of rigid COMPOSTABLE PLASTIC, including utensils, clamshells, bowls or portion cups. Our [Bainbridge Island City ordinance](#) requires that disposable food service ware be of **certified compostable fiber and PFAS-free**. (Exception: You may use clear PLA drink cups in 2023.) You can find **acceptable PFAS-free certified compostable fiber products** on this [BPI](#) or [OK Compost HOME](#) link. Please **DO NOT BUY any rigid compostable plastic** listed on those links for this event (except for clear PLA drink cups).

PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING:

Cold Cups - Clear drink cups are allowed in 2023 and must either be certified for commercial composting or accepted by your waste hauler for recycling. Please note that Bainbridge Disposal does not accept clear plastic cups for recycling at this time, so clear cold cups must be **commercially compostable bioplastic cups**. To meet this requirement, please purchase cups that are on the [BPI](#) or [OK Compost HOME](#) lists.

Hot Cups - Use compostable fiber cups ([BPI](#) or [OK Compost HOME](#)).

Tableware - Use **certified compostable fiber** for plates, bowls, deli paper and portion cups, **not compostable plastic**. Instead of portion cups, we encourage dispensing condiments in bulk.

Cold cup lids & straws – You may serve only on request. Straws must be of **certified compostable fiber**.

Utensils – **Wooden or other fiber types are required.** **See yellow highlight above.**

Napkins – Paper ones are compostable. Please do not give out wipes.

Food waste - Bring your food prep waste to a discard station compost cart (green cover). (No plastic gloves mixed in!)

Cardboard - Bring flattened cardboard to a discard station and place next to the recycling cart (blue lid). Soda boxes go directly into the recycling cart.

Plastic bag packaging – Keep your shaken-out bread bags, ice bags and bulk drink wrap separate from your trash. We will pick up and later take to local grocery stores' recycling bins.

Cooking grease and oil – Bainbridge Disposal has a cooking oil recovery station at the Vincent Road Transfer Station.




Vendor Parking Map

July 4th




